

View of Phase 1 of the Canada Water development (December 2023)

- The entrance to the haul road is on Lower Road.
- The haul road is closed until 5th February to accommodate utility works and mobile crane operation for Plot A1.
- A small number of construction vehicles will start to access the dock site from Surrey Quays Road.

Common working practices

Standard construction working hours:

- Monday Friday: 8am 6pm
- Saturday: 8am 2pm (no noisy works before 9am)
- When work outside of standard hours is needed, this will be agreed with Southwark Council and communicated in advance via our website: www.canadawater.co.uk /construction-activity
- Wates has adjusted their working hours to an additional hour on either side of standard working hours to enable the use of passenger hoists.

Plot A1

- The Founding comprises a new 35-storey building providing 186 new homes (including intermediate affordable homes).
- Three Deal Porters comprises workspace and retail.


Plot A2

- Dock Shed will be up to six storeys in height, providing new workspace, as well as shops and places for eating and drinking.
- Canada Water Leisure Centre will include an eight-lane swimming pool, a learner pool, gym, exercise studios, sports courts, soft play area and a café.



How is the build for The Founding and Three Deal Porters progressing?


The Founding



Construction of the façade of The Founding continues (December 2023)

- Works on the façade.
- The internal fit-out.
- Removal of protection screens and topping out.
- Completion in November 2024.

Three Deal Porters



- Works on the **façade**.
- Ground floor retail completion in October 2024.
- Office completion in November 2024.

Dock Office courtyard work





Illustration of plans for the Dock Office courtyard

- Work to the former Dock Office courtyard is due to begin in late February.
- Work will include the installation of a small pond, garden area, and extended courtyard.

Current work

- Exterior window glazing and external cladding.
- Internal wall construction.
- The internal **fit-out**.
- Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems are being introduced throughout each floor.

Upcoming work

- The fit-out of the leisure centre reception area and the swimming pools.
- Floor polishing in the office reception area.
- Removal of the final tower crane.
- **Planters** will be positioned on the building's rear terraces.
- **Steelwork** for the building's canopy.
- Internal glazing.

What is happening in the public realm for Plots A1 and A2?

- Work to the public realm around Plots A1 and A2 has begun.
- Changes to pedestrian and vehicle access are expected for approximately 4 months.
- Lane closure for southbound traffic to allow for pedestrian use.

Current work



Boardwalk construction underway in Canada Dock (December 2023)

- Boardwalk construction.
- Earthworks and deep soil mixing.
- Pedestrian access to the dock from Surrey Quays Road is restricted.

Upcoming work

- The Deal Porters Sculpture will be reinstated in the dock.
- **Timber piling** for the dipping pond.

- Further planting.
- Trial hole works along Maritime Street.






What is happening at Surrey Quays station?



New Surrey Quays Station Ticket Hall

- Transport for London are undertaking upgrades to Surrey Quays station including the construction of a new station entrance, featuring a spacious ticket hall and gateline.
- The upgrades will provide step-free access to both platforms via two new lifts.
- Longer platforms will reduce overcrowding at peak times.
- Works are due to complete by 2026.

Current work



- Key milestones reached over Christmas.
- Establishment of safe line side worksite.
- Demolition and removal of existing line side infrastructure.
- Installation of new temporary means of escape for the station.
- Installation of tower crane.

Upcoming work



Surrey Quays Station Upgrade (January 2024)

- Construction of pedestrian walkway along site boundary, Deal Porter Way.
- Unexploded ordnance probing
- Phase 1 of platform extensions.
- Installation of strip foundations Platform 1 and piling Platform 2
