Wider Canada Water development works

Further restoration works to the Grade II listed former Dock Offices are underway, including creating a sales and marketing suite. As part of the restoration works, landscaping works are taking place in the Dock Office courtyard starting this Autumn and due to complete by the end of this year. These works include the retention of four large trees, removal of two smaller ones, changes to levels, and planting a new garden.

Plot A1 will provide a new 35-storey building which will include retail, residential and office space. Expected completion in Autumn 2024.

Preparatory works continue at Canada Dock ahead of improvement works beginning in early 2023.

Plot K1 will include a modern five and six storey residential building providing 79 council homes on Roberts Close. Expected completion in Autumn 2023.

Work on a temporary 'life sciences' building next to TEDI's campus, is starting this September with completion of all the works planned for Spring/ Summer 2023.

At the rear of the Printworks site by Quebec Way, work is ongoing to build a basement for a new below-ground electricity

Enabling works for what are currently known as Printworks Street and Reel Street, which will include installation of ducting and utilities to facilitate Plots F. H. and L services are due to begin in October this

Plot A2 will include a leisure centre for Southwark Council at ground and basement level, town centre retail and food outlets along the new High Street, and workspace at the upper levels. Expected completion in Summer 2024.

Improvement works are currently underway in the Surrey Quays Shopping Centre car park and will finish before the end of 2022. These works include the diversion of a section of Deal Porters Way to create space for Transport for London's construction of a new level access entrance to Surrey Quays Station as well as the construction of a new footpath along Deal Porters Way opposite Plot A2.

Common working practices

Standard construction working hours:

- Monday Friday: 8am 6pm
- Saturday: 8am 2pm (no noisy works before 9am)
- When work outside of standard hours is needed, this will be agreed with Southwark Council and communicated in advance via our website: www.canadawater.co.uk /construction-activity



Noise, dust and vibration monitoring and reporting


- In line with industry standards and the Construction
 Management Plans for each development site, environmental
 management is a critical part of how construction works are
 managed.
- Noise, vibration and dust monitoring equipment are installed across the site to continuously monitor levels and ensure that they are within the levels agreed with Southwark Council's environment team.
- The monitors have 'trigger points' which alert the site team if noise, dust or vibration comes close to exceeding the approved maximum levels.
- If a trigger point is reached, relevant works stop as soon as safely practicable. The construction team investigate the source and consider mitigations to reduce the levels and impact on receptors.


Plot K1 – site location


Plot K1 – Site updates

- The concrete frame of the building is now visible from the outer boundaries of the site as it rises above the hoarding line
- Works to the frame will continue into the Autumn before precast façade (exterior of the building) can be installed to the outer facing elevations in mid-November



- Progress continues the new, below ground substation for UK Power Networks which supply power to the development as well as the local community
- Basement slab works were completed in July, allowing the build to continue up towards mezzanine and ground floor level





Enabling works for Printworks Street and Reel Street (as they are currently known)


Work will begin this month on the construction of new access roads and the installation of new below ground infrastructure.

This includes electricity, gas, water, telecoms, district heating (space proofing), surface water, foul water and irrigation.

Works include:

- Breaking out slab
- New hoarding installed along Quebec way footpath
- Removal of invasive species
- Tree clearance on Quebec Way
- Utility diversion from late October through to February along Quebec Way and Surrey Quays Road

Paper Yard (Buildings B and C) – site location



Paper Yard (Buildings B and C)

Work on Phase 2 of the temporary modular hub next to TEDI's campus began in September.

Completion of these works are planned for Spring/Summer 2023.

Works include:

- Slab construction in October and pouring of slabs in November
- Modular units delivered and installed in November and December this year 2022
- Thames Water/ UK Power Networks connections expected to begin this month
- Temporary traffic management will be required within Quebec Way

UK Power Networks

• UK Power Networks will be undertaking cable installation works in the New Cross area. New cables will supply the electricity for the new substation. Works will also take place on Carriage Drive in Southwark Park.

Some survey works will be carried out within the area between Canada Water Station and Quebec Way to establish ground information. They will provide notice to close residents via letter ahead of all works.
