

The Surrey Quays Centre is busiest on Fridays and weekends. School Holidays and Christmas time are also busy. At these times the centre can look quite different.

The quietest times are weekdays before 11.00am.

#### **How will I get to Surrey Quays Centre?**

The shopping centre has a large open car park and is located at SE16 7LL.

There is a maximum of 3 hours free parking.

Blue badge parking spaces can be found along the front of the building. Buses will drop you outside the entrance to the shopping centre. Taxis will also drop and pick up outside the shopping centre.

Canada Water Station and Surrey Quays Station are in walking distance from the shopping centre. There are also cycle racks outside the main entrances to the shopping centre to secure your bike whilst you shop.

At the moment there are a lot of construction works taking place in the shopping centre car park. This re-development work is known as the Canada Water Masterplan. You may see more activity than usual in and around the car park. The construction activity is regularly managed so that disruption is minimised but please do let centre staff know if this concerns you when you visit.

#### Where are our toilet facilities?

The Surrey Quays centre has well-signed toilet facilities, parent and baby rooms and disability / accessibility toilets on both the ground and first floors. A Radar key can be picked up from our security control room.



#### **How Will I Be Supported?**

Security Control can be found through the doors at the end of the corridor shown in the picture above and next to Centre Management Office. Manual wheelchairs can also be loaned from here. Our centre is well-signed visually, and many signs are also in braille. Some staff can also greet in British Sign Language!








A number of stores have an Induction Hearing Loop System. Please contact stores for more information.
